A well kept Spanish secret...

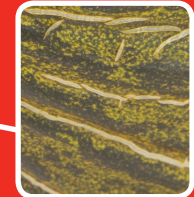
Now grown in Australia!

- Clear maturity indicators mean growers can deliver great tasting melons every time
- Piel de Sapo means 'skin of the frog' in Spanish
- Some Australian growers also call them Crocodile or 'Croc melons'!

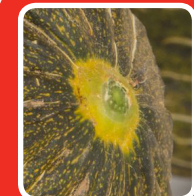
How to pick a good one? The uglier the better!



The green skin starts to go a mottled olive & yellow colour



As the fruit ripens a 'net' of lines appear (sometimes called 'sugar cracks'!)



Look for the 'gold coin' around the stem scar
